MAINTENANCE WORKER (3.02)

DESCRIPTION

This is semi-skilled work of considerable variety pertaining to the maintenance/ construction of grounds, buildings, and equipment. The work may involve the performance of semi-skilled manual tasks requiring some trade skills. It may also include some truck driving and equipment operating tasks.

Some initiative and judgment may be required in solving work problems but complex or policy problems are referred to a supervisor.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Performs a variety of semi-skills manual and trade tasks relative to the maintenance and repair of:
  - playground equipment
  - lawns gardens, grounds and nursery stock
  - planting and sprinkling
  - application of pesticides
  - sidewalks and blacktop areas/ditches and sumps
  - desks, furniture and lockers
  - windows and replacement of broken glass
  - fences, goal posts, back stops, jumping pits, etc.
  - broken and defective electrical fixtures
- Lays tile
- Landscapes and falls trees
- Plants, sprinkles and applies pesticides
- Paints, sands and refinishes
- Replaces broken locks, door closures, sky lights and plumbing fixtures
- constructs concrete forms, walls and foundations
- Performs other assigned comparable duties which are within the scope and knowledge, skills and abilities required by this position

• Hand tools, buffers, chain saws, sprayers, compressors, paint brushes, power drills/sweeper/saws/Hilti, jackhammer, lawn mowers, cement mixer, sprinkler equipment, sewer auger, power generator, sanders, tractor and accessories and truck
