What is the Trades Sampler Program?

- Trades Sampler exposes interested students to various construction and mechanical trades as they explore hands on units related to trades careers.
- Depending on the year, the program will run with a cohort of students at Brooks Secondary, part time (half days) all year September - June or full time (full days) in one semester.



What credits can a student earn in the program?

Students will earn a total of 16 high school credits at either the Grade 11 or 12 level.

What comes after the Trades Sampler Program?

Students can pursue a trades pathway (dual credit options for non grad, U-19 students) at the conclusion of the program. Dual credit trades programs are full time yearlong programs, such as:

- Automotive
- Carpentry
- Welding
- Or other trades programs through NIC in Campbell River or VIU in Nanaimo:
 - Plumbing
 - Electrical
 - Heavy Duty



Who can sign up for the Trades Sampler Program?

The Trades Sampler Program is available to Grade 11&12 students who:

- are curious/interested about pursuing a pathway in the trades;
- have a high degree of commitment and maturity;
- have the ability to work as part of a team; and
- have a good attendance record.
