

tiystəm (tee stum) - Respect (September)


When we see others, deeply and honestly, and care for them in a way that they need, we create relationships of respect. Honour la?amin connections to the land and strive for a balance in our lives.

tiyhɛgən mɛtəm (tee hegun metum) - Integrity (October)

This is Henderson School's fifth year hosting the project and we look forward to working with supporting community partners to spread many smiles in the month of December as will classes from James Thomson School, Texada School, Westview School, Kelly Creek Community School and Edgehill School.

In November and December, students at Henderson will be painting gift bags and creating personal cards to include in the *Everybody Deserves A Smile* bags.

Each bag also includes a hat, wool socks, mittens, Christmas cookies, and hygiene items.

Last year Henderson School created 487 bags and this year we hope to create 500 bags to be distributed within our local community.
