**What Do I Need to Graduate?** In order to graduate students must complete:

**REQUIRED COURSES:**

- English Language Arts 10
- Français langue seconde-immersion 10
- English Language Arts 11
- a Français langue seconde-immersion course 11
- English Studies 12
- Français langue seconde-immersion 12
- Social Studies 10
- a Social Studies 11 or 12
- Science 10
- a Science 11 or 12
- a Mathematics 10
- a Mathematics 11 or 12
- Physical and Health Education 10
- Career Life Education 10
- Career Life Connections 12
- an ADST or Arts Education 10, 11, or 12

**OTHER REQUIREMENTS:**

- a *minimum* of 20 courses (80 credits) total from Grade 10, 11, and 12
- a *minimum* of 4 courses (16 credits) required at the **Grade 12 level**
  - at least 12 more credits in Grade 10, 11, or 12 courses that are in **French** with at least 4 of these credits at the Grade 11 or 12 level
  - 4 credits in Indigenous-focused coursework
  - Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment
  - Grade 10 Literacy Assessment
  - Grade 12 Literacy Assessment
  - Évaluation de littératie de la 12e année
  - 30 hours of Volunteer/Work Experience
