

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

If you wish to vote by mail, you must complete and return a Mail Ballot Voting Application to the Chief Election officer.

Applications to vote by mail may be requested as follows:

A Mail Ballot package will ONLY be issued to eligible voters and if the application is complete and correctly filled out.

Mail Ballot applications can be made beginning March 3, 2025 and Mail Ballot packages are expected to be available for distribution on or before March 25, 2025.

Remember, in order for your mail ballot to be counted, it **MUST** be received by the Chief Election Officer no later than **8:00 pm** on **Saturday**, **April 12**, **2025**.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Complete this application form AND email, fax, mail, or deliver it to the Chief Election Officer [contact information on page 2].
- 2. IF your application is received, complete and you qualify to vote by mail ballot, a package will be sent to you as soon as the ballots are available [late March]. IF we receive your application after Monday, March 31, 2025 at 12 noon, the time may be insufficient for mailing and receipt of the ballot; therefore, we recommend that you arrange to pick up a mail ballot package from the School District office [4351 Ontario Avenue, Powell River, BC V8A 1V3].
- 3. You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot and documents are received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8:00 pm on General Voting Day, Saturday, April 12, 2025.

Document identifying electors

- **3.** The classes of documents that may be accepted as evidence for the purposes of section 72 or 73 of the *Local Government Act*, or for the purposes of section 30 or 30.1 of the *Vancouver Charter* are
 - (a) a British Columbia Driver's Licence,
 - (b) a BC Identification Card within the meaning of the Identification Card Regulation,
 - (b.1) a photo BC services card within the meaning of the Identification Card Regulation,
 - (b.2) a non-photo BC services card within the meaning of the Identification Card Regulation,
 - (c) an Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle Licence issued by the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia,
 - (d) a British Columbia CareCard or British Columbia Gold CareCard,
 - (e) a Ministry of Social Development and Economic Security Request for Continued Assistance Form SDES8,
 - (f) a Social Insurance Number card or confirmation of Social Insurance Number letter issued by the government of Canada,
 - (g) a Citizenship Card issued by Citizenship and Immigration Canada,
 - (h) a real property tax notice issued under section 237 of the Community Charter or section 21 of the Taxation (Rural Area) Act,
 - (i) a credit card or debit card issued by a savings institution as defined in section 29 of the Interpretation Act, or
 - (j) a utility bill issued for the supply of electricity, natural gas, water, telephone services or coaxial cable services by
 - (i) a public utility as defined in section 1 of the Utilities Commission Act,
 - (ii) a gas utility as defined in section 1 of the Gas Utility Act,
 - (iii)a water utility as defined in section 1 of the Water Utility Act,

(iv)the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority, or

(v) a corporation licensed by the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission for the purposes of that supply.
