

DISTRICT PARENTS' ADVISORY COUNCIL

Background

The District supports the establishment of a District Parents' Advisory Council, as defined in the School Act. The District Parents' Advisory Council may advise the Board on any matter relating to education in the District.

Procedures

- 1. The District Parents' Advisory Council is to be made up of one elected representative from each school Parents' Advisory Council.
- 2. The District Parents' Advisory Council, in consultation with the Superintendent, must make bylaws governing its meetings and the business and conduct of its affairs, including bylaws governing the dissolution of the Council.
