## Spice for Life 2 Training

Auditory Outreach is considering hosting a Spice for Life 2 asynchronous training session. This workshop is designed to teach speech-language pathologists and teachers of the d/Deaf techniques to help children with hearing loss listen in everyday situations. Participants learn an overview of skills including: improving auditory memory and comprehension, listening with technology, conversing, listening in noise, localizing sounds and more.
