RECEIVER INSTALLATION/UN-INSTALLATION IS ...


- the act of physically adding/removing a Roger receiver from a hearing aid in a digitized way by transferring a "code"





RECEIVER INSTALLATION IS NOT

- RM/FM fitting
- RM/FM verification
- RM/FM matching



WHEN TO PERFORM RECEIVER UN-INSTALLATION



- To troubleshoot equipment malfunction
- To isolate receiver or hearing aid to send to Auditory Outreach or HA manufacturer for technical service
- To safekeep RM receiver during school breaks, i.e. summer, winter, spring holidays
- When student is moving/graduating out of school district

YOU WILL NEED:

- Roger Installer by Phonak
- Roger X receiver (empty "shell")
- Hearing aid (compatible with Roger Direct)
 with good battery
- Transmitter (for checking RM status)



How to un-install a Roger X receiver from a Hearing Aid:

- 1. Power OFF hearing aid.
- 2. Plug Roger X shell into Installer.
- 3. Power ON Installer.
- 4. Power ON hearing aid.
- 5. Place hearing aid on Installer.
- 6. When light beside receiver turns green, receiver has been uninstalled. Remove hearing aid from Installer.
- 7. Power OFF Installer and unplug receiver for safe storage.


How to re-install a Roger X receiver onto a Hearing Aid:


- 1. Power OFF hearing aid.
- 2. Plug Roger X receiver into Installer.
- 3. Power ON Installer.
- 4. Power ON hearing aid.
- 5. Place hearing aid on Installer.
- 6. When light beside hearing aid turns green, receiver has been reinstalled. Remove hearing aid from Installer.
- 7. Power OFF Installer and unplug receiver (empty) for safe storage.

IMPORTANT TIPS:

- During un/re-installation, other Installers and Phonak hearing aids with Roger Direct should be at least 3 metres away
- Only Roger X receivers with SN 1744... or higher can be installed
- Only hearing aids with Roger Direct can take installed receivers, e.g *Marvel, Paradise, Lumity* families of hearing aids
- Installer takes one AAA battery. To avoid rust build-up, best to remove battery when not using Installer.
