This week's theme is OCEAN

RECIPES FUN SNACKS THAT LOOK LIKE ANIMALS FROM THE SEA

YUMMY, TASTY AND CUTE SNACKS

Jellyfish Sandwiches

- 1. Spread equal amounts of natural peanut butter and fruit spread on bread to form two sandwiches.
- 2. Cut into jellyfish shapes with a round drinking glass, cutting curved bottom with scissors.
- 3. Pull apart string cheese and arrange underneath the sandwiches to resemble jellyfish tentacles. Use banana slices and raisins for eyes and a slice of celery for a smile.

Octopus English Muffin

- 1. Spread cream cheese on half of english muffin
- 2. Place whole strawberry in the centre of the english muffin of the octopus body
- 3. Slice another strawberry into thin vertical strips for the legs and arrange around octopuses body.
- 4. Place on candy eyes

Banana Dolphins Swimming in Fruit

- 1. Slice bottom of banana off so it can stand in a cup or bowl
- 2. Slice into top of banana and place a round piece of fruit in the dolphins mouth. You can use a pen to make the eye as it will not be eaten.
- 3. Surround the dolphin with fruit

Clam Sandwiches

- 1. Place thin slice of ham or other meat and a thin slice of cheese between 2 pieces of bread
- 2.Cut the bread using scissors or cookie cutter into shape of clam
- 3. Open and place a grape inside as the pearl

Materials

- Paper plate or paper bowl
- Paint
- Glitter (optional) or other decorations
- Tape or glue
- Assortment of ribbon, curly ribbon, wool, rick rack string.
- Googly eyes (bought or made)

Directions:

- 1. Paint plate or bowl and sprinkle with glitter or other decorations
- 2. If using a paper plate you can cut a squiggly line across the bottom of the plate.
- 3. Tape or glue ribbon, wool, string etc. To under edge of plate or bowl.
- 4. Attach a string or ribbon to hang up your beautiful, colourful jellyfish!







FISH SPONGE TOSS:

This is fun to do with dry fish or wet fish!

- 1. Make a target- draw a target using sidewalk chalk, or use a bucket or hola hoop. Throw your fish at the target
- 2.OR... play "Catch the Fish". One person throws (adult) it and the other person (child) catches it in a bucket!

Catching and throwing requires strength and also develops great hand-eye coordination. Plus it's a lot of fun. You'll love playing with your kids!

HOW TO MAKE AN OCEAN IN A BOTTLE:

- 1. Take a bottle (a 2 litre pop bottle, shampoo bottle, mouthwash bottle etc) and fill it approximately 1/3 full of water.
- 2. Add several drops of blue food colouring.
- 3. Have your child shake the bottle to mix up the water and food colouring.
- 4. Fill the rest of the bottle with oil. Put the lid on (i usually glue it on) and have fun
