## **BEACH FUN**

## **RECIPES**

#### **KINETIC SAND**

1 cup of play sand (beach sand) 1/2 tbsp corn starch 1 tsp dish soap



#### **METHOD**

- Begin by combining the play sand and corn starch in a large bin or container. Mix well.
- In a separate container combine 1 cup of water with 1 tsp of dish soap, and stir until the water is bubbly.
- Slowly add the water-mixture to the sand/cornstarch and mix well.

#### SALT DOUGH STAR FISH

2 cups of flour 1 cup of salt 1 cup of water Baking pan Toothpick

## FUN STARFISH FACTS FOR KIDS

- Starfish are not actually fish but related to sea urchins and sand dollars!
- This sea creature can live for 30 years or more.
- A starfish can regrow an arm if it loses it.
- Starfish have tube feet and a mouth in the middle of their body on their lower side.

#### **METHOD**

- Preheat the oven to 250 degrees.
- In a large mixing bowl, combine the flour, water, and salt and mix well using a hand or stand mixer.
- Form your dough into a star fish shape.
- Smooth out the star and use a toothpick to make a line into each star arm.
- Bake for 2 hours and then let cool. Alternatively, leave the salt dough out to air-dry!









## **ART FROM THE BEACH**

### **TIE-DYED SHELLS**

#### **MATERIALS**

- shells- The nice white shells gathered from the beach work best!
- shaving cream
- food colouring
- toothpicks or something to mix with
- paper towels. (you will need quite a lot)

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Fill your tray with shaving cream and squeeze your food coloring onto the shaving cream.
- 2. Using the bamboo skewers or toothpick make a marbled pattern in the shaving cream.
- 3. Dip a shell into the marbled shaving cream, we dipped the shells and then scooped up the shaving cream a bit. Let it sit with the shaving cream for a minute or so. Then taking a paper towel, wipe off the shaving cream to reveal the amazing patterns underneath!





Experiment with creating different patterns and color combinations. I also tried dipping one side of a shell in one color and then dipping another side in another color, letting the colors overlap slightly. I love how this process turned out!

(Sit on floor)


Smiling kids in the sea
